Every manager, employee, contractor and visitor must be committed to working in a safe manner and to identify potential hazards so they can be corrected before an accident occurs.


We believe that all accidents, work related ill health and incidents are preventable and our goal is to achieve NO accidents, we believe that even one injury is one to many.
